In 2020 KECA's educators delivered programs to more than 41,000 students and guests. We also improved more than 400 acres of habitat for elk and a wide variety of other wildlife across Pennsylvania's Elk Country. The Wapiti West Chapter Committee and I are looking forward to spending a very memorable, enjoyable, and high energy day supporting and celebrating all that we do for PA Elk Country.
